

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHEN MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- All on-course Native/Fescue Grass areas are defined as red penalty areas.
- Sprinkler head yardage markers are measured to center of green.
- Keep carts on paths on all par 3's, on paths near all tees and greens and out of all fescue/native grass areas.
- For your safety please keep all carts out of the parking lot.
- Everything left of the cart path on Hole #16, excluding out-of-bounds, is considered within the margin of a red penalty area. Also, any ball coming to rest on the path left of Hole #16 may utilize designated drop area for free relief as an additional option.
- Trespassing on homeowner's property is prohibited.
- Pin Placements are marked on the maroon and white striped 150 yard post.
Red - Front White - Middle Blue - Back
- Hawks Landing is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of personal property.
- Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1 - Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect.
- Model Local Rule E-5 is in effect. (Allowing the alternative for stroke & distance)
- Cart paths are immovable obstructions.
- All drains, drain covers and large embedded boulders located within the native/fescue grass areas are deemed immovable obstructions within penalty areas and thus free relief is not granted. The player must play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 17.1.
- The silo, the artificial rock wall and the flower bed located within the artificial rock wall on the left side of Hole #9 are within the margin of the native/fescue grass. They are also deemed as integral objects and therefore free relief is not granted. Players may play the ball as it lies or proceed under Rule 17 and incur a one-stroke penalty.
- The entire margin of the ornamental flower bed within the water feature hazard near nine green is considered a NO PLAY ZONE. Players must take one-stroke penalty relief under Rule 17.1e.

PACE OF PLAY IS 4 HOURS 16 MINUTES OR LESS

It is the responsibility of each group to keep pace with the group ahead. If your group falls more than one complete hole behind the group ahead, you may be asked to pick up your ball and move forward into position. The ranger has the authority to keep play moving at the proper pace for all players enjoyment.
